## Options You Might Be Eligible For

### Lower Costs on Marketplace Coverage

Based on the information you provided, you may be able to get lower costs for your monthly premiums and out-of-pocket costs when you get insurance through the Marketplace. ### Medicaid

Based on the information you provided, you could be eligible for free or low-cost health coverage through Medicaid, which provides coverage to millions of Americans with limited incomes or disabilities. ### The Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP)

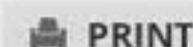

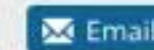

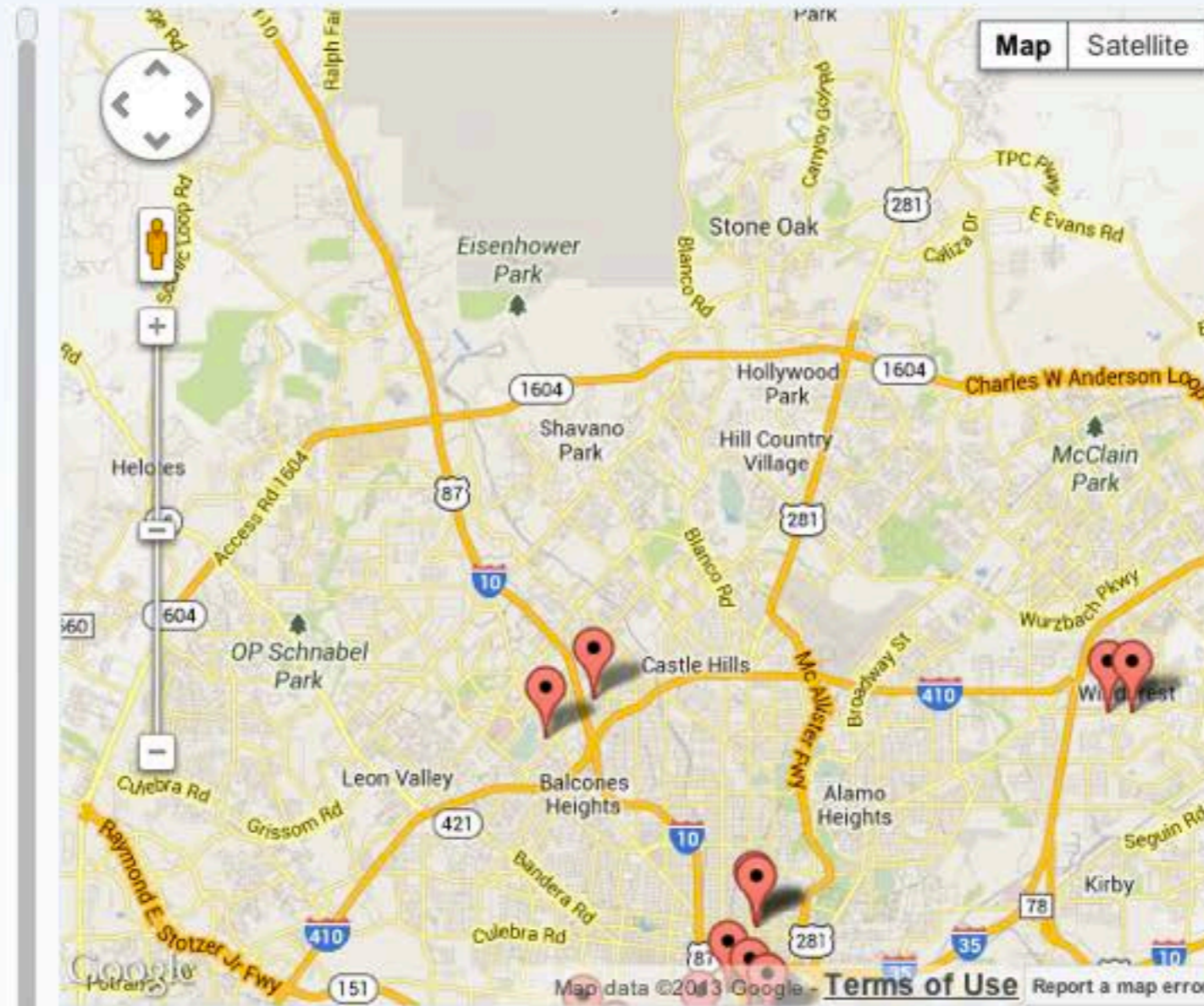
